- Applicant must be in the 7<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> grade except for the Organ Scholarship.
- Applicant must have studied with an accredited instructor for one or more years and be a member of a band or chorale group.
- A letter of recommendation from the present instructor is required.
- Performed selections must include two contrasting pieces of music.
- One selection must be MEMORIZED.
- Applicants must provide an original score for the judges.
- Students who have already received two scholarships from the St. Clair Music Club are not eligible, with the exception of the organ scholarship.
- A written application with requirements must be received by Tuesday, May 7, 2019.

## ST. CLAIR MUSIC CLUB 2019 SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

## PIANO, VOICE, BRASS, WOODWIND, PERCUSSION, ORCHESTRAL STRINGS

The St. Clair Music Club, in cooperation with the Community Foundation of St. Clair County, will be offering music scholarships to further the winner's music education.

- 1. An applicant must be a resident or student within the East China School District including parochial, private and home-schooled students.
- 2. Applicant must be currently in grades **7 through 11**.
- 3. Applicant must have studied with an accredited music teacher for one or more years **and/or** be a member of a school band or chorale group.
- 4. A letter of recommendation from the present music teacher is required.
- 5. Performed selections must include two pieces of contrasting style which will show technique, versatility and command of the instrument. Novelty tunes or pop music are not recommended.
- 6. One of the selections must be memorized.
- 7. Applicant must provide original music score for the judges at the auditions.
- 8. Three photo copies **for this one time use only** of the music selections must be submitted for the judges with your application. **Each measure must be numbered on these photocopies**.
- 9. Students that have already received two scholarships from the St. Clair Music Club are not eligible.
- 10. Dress slacks, skirts or dresses are appropriate attire for auditions.
- 11. Written applications must contain the following information.
  - St. Clair Music Club Application Form.
  - A letter of recommendation from your present music teacher.
  - Three photo copies of your selections for this one time use only.

## ST. CLAIR MUSIC CLUB 2019 SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

#### **ORGAN**

The St. Clair Music Club, in cooperation with the Community Foundation of St. Clair County, will be offering music scholarships to further the winner's music education.

- 1. An applicant must be a resident or student within the East China School District including parochial, private and home-schooled students.
- 2. Applicant must be at least in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade and no older than 25 years of age at the time of the scholarship tryouts. Person with a Bachelor's Degree are not eligible. If there are no applicants in this age limit, the age may extend to 50 years of age.
- 3. Applicant must have studied with an accredited organ instructor for one or more years.
- 4. A letter of recommendation from the present organ instructor is required.
- 5. Performed selections must include two contrasting pieces of classical organ literature employing both manuals and pedals. **They do not have to be memorized.**
- 6. The selections can be any composer in any style and arranged especially for the organ.
- 7. Applicant must provide original music score for the judges at the tryouts.
- 8. Three photo copies **for this one time use only** of the music selections must be submitted for the judges with your application. **Each measure must be numbered on these photocopies**.
- 9. <u>For this scholarship only,</u> students that may have already received two scholarships from the St. Clair Music Study Club are eligible to audition for the Organ Scholarship.
- 10. Dress slacks, skirts or dresses are appropriate attire for auditions.
- 11. Written applications must contain the following information.
  - a. St. Clair Music Club Application Form
  - b. A letter of recommendation from your present music teacher.
  - c. Three photo copies of your selections for this one time use only.
