Submit a video of their performance. a. Deadline is in March 31. b. Performance must include: i. Two or three pieces from different music eras, in contrasting styles, less than 15 total minutes duration. ii. Pieces written with accompanist, must be recorded with accompanist. iii. Video Recording must be sent to ruthsmusiclessons@sbcglobal.net , Include: applicant's name, title of pieces and composers. iv. Photocopy of pieces, with measures numbered, can be submitted electronically to ruthsmusiclessons@sbcglobal.net , or mailed to Ruth Fry (address below). Judges will destroy the copies after use.
